# **Great Courses**Wednesday February 13 10:00 AM

This month we will be offering our members Great Courses Turning Points in American History 1989 Collapse- The End of the Cold War. The filmed lecture by Professor Edward T. O'Donnell, Associate Professor of History at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, Ma lasts around 30 minutes. The cold war dominated U.S. politics from 1945 to the early 199s. It led to massive military expenditures and several major wars and proxy conflicts. At home, Americans lived in constant fear of nuclear annihilation and communist subversives in their own backyards. The collapse of the Soviet bloc, starting with East Germany in 1989, ended the cold war and left America in the welcome but unexpected position of being the world's only superpower.



## February 6- Cane River Creole National Park, Louisiana

This unique Louisiana park includes 44.16 acres of Oakland Plantation and 18.75 acres of Magnolia Plantation. The two park sites include a total of 67 historic structures remnant from 200 years of plantation life. Descendants of the plantations' owners and descendants of the plantations' laborers remained on the land through periods of prosperity and depression, war and peace, and dramatic changes in governments, agriculture, technology, and labor systems. 
