REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

- **NOTE:** Registration begins on **April 15th, 2010**
- Includes all programs **EXCEPT:** K-5 Camps, Middle School Camp, Facility Reservations and Pool Passes.

PROCEDURE:

- Please enclose one form for each person.
- You are enrolled unless otherwise notified.
- **NO** acknowledgement of registration will be made.
- **Fees MUST** be paid at time of registration, **CASH or CHECK ONLY!**

NON-RESIDENT POLICY:

- Non-residents may register **AFTER** April 22, 2010.
- Fees are an **ADDITIONAL 50%** of program fee.
- Class selection **IS** limited for non-residents.
- Registration for non-residents **EXCLUDES** camps, swimming lessons and pool passes.

PROGRAM REFUNDS:

- **NO** refunds are possible after the first day of class. Prior to that, 50% of registration is non-refundable.
- **TRIP REFUNDS:** There are **NO** refunds for trips unless canceled by the Recreation Department. Trips **ARE** open to non-residents.
- **CRAFT CLASS REFUNDS:** There are **NO** refunds for craft classes.

- **CAMP LOCATIONS TO BE DETERMINED AT A LATER DATE!**
- When registering your child, it is the grade they are entering in the fall of 2010.
- Registration is by walk-in only beginning Monday, April 19, 2010.
- Registration forms are available on line or at the Parks and Rec office.
- Camp runs from 9:00-2:00 pm, Monday through Thursday.
- You **MUST** register for trips at the time of registration. There will be **NO** camp held on trip days.
- **Please** send your child with a lunch and beverages every day!

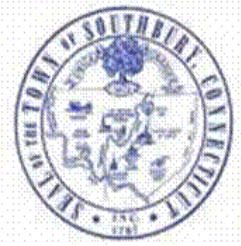
