Advisory Opinion Case 24-001a

While the Ethics Commission typically responds to external requests for advice and/or complaints, our procedures permit us the ability to issue unsolicited ad-hoc advice as well. A question has arisen concerning a section of the Code of Ethics and how it relates to concurrent public offices and the Charter Revision Commission.

Every five years the town is required to assemble a commission for the purposes of revising the Town Charter. The group is called the Charter Revision Commission. A question arose during the preparation for and selection of the membership for the upcoming Charter Revision Commission. The question was "Can a member of the Ethics Commission participate as a member of the Charter Revision Commission?".

The Ethics Commission has reviewed language in the Code of Ethics and has determined that pursuant to the Code of Ethics, Section 2-41, Sub-Section (I), Sub-Sub-Section (3) concerning concurrent public offices that the Charter Revision Commission is to be considered a *temporary* commission or committee. Therefore, the First Selectman, the Town Clerk, members of the Board of Finance and members of the Ethics Commission are <u>not restricted</u> from being appointed as members of the Charter Revision Commission unless otherwise prohibited in the Town Charter or by ordinance.
