- 1. Are we able to use an additional person for traffic control or are we required to use a traffic control company or the Police Department, and if so, are we responsible for the cost of using the Police Department?**
  - a. The bidder may choose whether to use their own employees, a traffic control company, or the Southbury Police Department, however, all costs of such are to be borne by the bidder and included in the bid price.
- 2. Who bid on this work previously and who/what was the winning bid?**
  - a. See attached sheet. Please note that the low bidder for items 4 and 5 proved unsuited for the project, and the awarded contractor for items 1-3 was ultimately awarded 4 and 5 as well.
- 3. Is the bid “time on job site” or a daily rate? Will travel to and from the site be paid?**
  - a. The bid is for time on the job site. Per the specifications, “Invoices shall be calculated based on actual hours worked. Travel time must be included as part of the hourly rates and will not be paid for separately.”
- 4. What are the pay terms: net 15 or net 30?**
  - a. Net 30.
