Question 1:

Will the Town allow Program Partners to move budget between tasks, as long as the total budget does not exceed the proposed not to exceed amount?

Answer to Question 1:

The Town has been awarded \$157,160 across three phases. Phase 1, Groundwork (\$17,000), will establish the Town's baseline waste management ecosystem, assess stakeholder sentiment, and work with the Waste Advisory Committee to design a town-specific waste reduction program. This phase will produce the data, models, and local support needed to determine whether to proceed with implementation. Phase 2, Implementation (\$105,160), will launch the program, coordinate vendors, educate residents, and provide tools and start-up incentives. Phase 3, Monitoring (\$35,000), will evaluate program results on an ongoing basis, maintain public engagement, and support the program's transition to a self-sustaining model.

Proposals for each phase must not exceed the DEEP-approved funding allocated to that phase, as listed above.

Question 2:
