First Selectman O'Neil called the special meeting of the board of selectmen to order at 6:30 pm in room 205A of the Southbury Town Hall.
All joined in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Selectwoman DeCarli moved to enter executive session for the purpose of a pre-disciplinary hearing concerning Officer Gary Corigliano, and invited Attorney William Ryan, Attorney Bucci, Attorney Daigle Gary Corigliano, Deonna Corigliano, Chief Grillo, Deputy Chief Cifone, Tim Webster, Officer Cook, Sgt.
