Alcohol to go is here to stay for at least three years

A new Connecticut law will allow restaurants to keep selling alcoholic drinks to takeout customers for the next three years. The to-go drinks, which helped drum up extra business when the pandemic forced restaurants to close their doors, applies only to bottles of wine and other sealed alcoholic beverages and must be accompanied by the purchase of food. *Hartford Courant*
