State & Federal

Did you apply for a Connecticut CARES grant? If approved you should have received an e-mail requiring you to electronically sign the Connecticut CARES Grant Assistance Agreement. Failure to respond may result in these funds being reallocated to other CT small businesses. Press release from DECD Commissioner on the Federal \$900 billion stimulus package

- \$325 billion for small businesses, including \$284 billion in loans through the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP)
- Direct payment checks of up to \$600 per adult and child
- Enhanced unemployment insurance benefits of \$300 per week
- Extension of the eviction moratorium and \$25 billion for rental assistance
- Extension of the tax credit for employers offering paid sick leave
