SOUTHBURY COVID-19 BUSINESS UPDATE

June 30 is the last day for the SBA to assign a loan number to businesses who have applied and are approved for a PPP loan. This means you must have applied and been approved before the June 30 deadline.

There are still some local banks and online lenders accepting applications but be aware lenders will have their own deadlines in order for them to meet the June 30 deadline.

Contact CT-SBDC today if you are still looking to apply and have not had success.

You may also want to check out the SBA's <u>Lender Match</u>, an online tool for small businesses to be matched with Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs), Minority Depository Institutions (MDIs), Certified Development Companies (CDCs), Micro-lenders, as well as traditional smaller asset size lenders in the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). SBA's Lender Match is an additional resource for pandemic-affected small businesses who have not applied for or received an approved PPP loan to connect with lenders.
